Character Goals: Hiding the truth and controlling Astrid.




Meredith Costas

Character Goals: Leading Astrid to find the truth, ultimately to separate her son from her.






Objective

Develop and produce a cinematic story that conveys realistic uniiversal themes of being in a relationship.


Target Audience







Director's Statement

"When I wrote the script of Delusion it started as a reference of one of my close friends story. However, while I was writing I experiencing the story myself, being with someone that lied about who they were and when I found out it felt like the person that I was with for two years was a completely different person. The story became very personal and I was very attached to it. But when I start casting the roles, to the filming and releasing it to an audicience, it will fell less and less mine in each stage, just like Baldwin said "Nothing, none of it belongs to you. You can only have it by letting it go." You can only take if you are prepared to give, and giving is not an investment. It is not a day at the bargain counter. "It is a total risk of everything, of you and who you think you are, who you think you'd like to be, where you think you would like to go everything, and this forever, forever". (Balwin 9) I relate to this so much because I'm risking everything emotionally, physically to bring this story to life, and also letting the story be its own film separated from my own experience. The film will be able to adapt its own nature. It was the second time I opened myself emotionally to a deeper level that made me feel so uncomfortable but pushed me to create a script filled with emotions, hoping that people will feel connected to it. My main purpose with it is uncovering an experience that I felt very embarrassed of talking about and sharing it with others so they could feel that not every first relationship is beautiful, romantic and easy, it can also be toxic, confusing and emotionally draining. In that way I feel the people that will watch the film will also risk to let themselves go into a journey with the character that was feeling betrayed, heart broken and unvalued, which are universal feelings that many people most likely had experienced before."
